1. WORLD YOUTH GAMES CATEGORIES & FORMAT

1.1. CATEGORIES

The disciplines and their relative categories are indicated in the table hereafter:

Category	Age
Cadets	15 and 16 years old
Minimes	13 and 14 years old
Benjamins	11 and 12 years old
Poussins	9 and 10 years old
Girls	Up to 15 years old

All categories are open as far as bike/wheel size. Categories depend on age. The age class a rider is eligible to ride is determined by his age, which shall be calculated by deducting the year of birth from the current year.

1.2. COMPETITION FORMAT

The Trials World Youth Games race shall include a Qualification round, followed by a Final round in each category.

If the category has more than 16 riders, the best **12** riders from the Qualification round will be eligible to compete in the Final round.

If the category has between 11 and 16 riders, the best **8** riders from the Qualification round will be eligible to compete in the Final round.

If the category has less than 11 riders, there will be no Qualification round.

UCI Trials World Youth Games Qualification round

The Qualification round shall consist of 3 rounds of 6 sections. The competition time will be set by the commissaries panel.

UCI Trials World Youth Games Final round

The scores gained in the Qualification round do not count in the Final round. Each finalist starts with zero points. The competition time for the Final round shall be 1h 30m per category.

2. REGISTRATIONS AND CLASSIFICATION OF RIDERS

2.1. ENTRIES

Riders wishing to compete in the UCI Trials World Youth Games may register only under the auspices and through their National federation. All competition entry dates must be adhered to and no late entries will be accepted. All entry forms must be forwarded to the UCI office.

2.2. QUALIFIED RIDERS

UCI Trials World Youth Games Qualification round

The UCI Trials World Youth Games event will commence with a Qualification round. In total each national federation shall be permitted to register up to 5 riders in each category. The host federation may register a greater number of riders, with a maximum of 6 riders in each category.

UCI Trials World Youth Games Final round

If the category has more than 16 riders, the best 12 riders from the Qualification round will be eligible to compete in the Final round.

If the category has between 11 and 16 riders, the best 8 riders from the Qualification round will be eligible to compete in the Final round.

If the category has less than 11 riders there will be no Qualification round.
