1. WORLD CUP CATEGORIES & DISCIPLINES

1.1. DISCIPLINES

The disciplines and their relative categories are indicated in the table hereafter:

Discipline	Category
20" Trials	Combined Elite/Juniors Men
26" Trials	Combined Elite/Juniors Men
Open	Women

1.2. CATEGORIES

Categories depend on age. The age class a rider is eligible to ride is determined by his age, which shall be calculated by deducting the year of birth from the current year.

Category	Age
Elite & Juniors Men	16 years and over
Women	15 years and over

1.3. GENERAL FORMAT

Each Trials World Cup race shall include a **1/4 Final round**, a **1/2 Final round**, a **Final round** and a **Super Final round** in each men category. The best 15 riders from the 1/4 Final round will be eligible to compete in the 1/2 Final round. The best 8 riders in the 1/2 Final round will be eligible to compete in the Final round. The best 4 riders in the Final round will be eligible to compete in the Super Final round.

In the Women's category, each Trials World Cup is one single event.

1.3.1. Two days competition

- **1/4 Final round**

The 1/4 Final round shall consist of 2 laps of 6 sections.

The 1/4 Final round is open to all non-qualified riders. Minimum number of riders per category: eight.

- **1/2 Final round**

The 1/2 Final round shall consist of 2 laps of 6 sections.

The competition time shall be 2 hours 15 min.

The best 15 riders from the 1/4 Final round will be eligible to compete in the 1/2 Final round together the 10 highest ranked riders on the UCI ranking.

More riders can qualify if the number of directly qualified (from the UCI ranking) is less than ten riders.

- **Final round**

The Final round shall consist of 2 laps of 6 sections.

Best 8 riders in the 1/2 Final round will be eligible to compete in the Final round.

The scores gained in the 1/2 Final round do not count in the Final round. Each finalist starts with zero points. The Final round will run as per article 7.3.008 at the UCI Trials rulebook.

1.3.2. Three days competition

- **1/4 Final round**

The 1/4 Final round shall consist of 2 laps of 6 sections.

The 1/4 Final round is open to all non-qualified riders. Minimum number of riders per category: eight.

- **1/2 Final round**

The 1/2 Final round shall consist of 2 laps of 6 sections.

The competition time shall be 2 hours 15 min.

The best 15 riders from the 1/4 Final round will be eligible to compete in the 1/2 Final round together the 10 highest ranked riders on the UCI ranking.

More riders can qualify if the number of directly qualified (from the UCI ranking) is less than ten riders.

- **Final round**

The Final round shall consist of 2 laps of 6 sections.

Best 8 riders in the 1/2 Final round will be eligible to compete in the Final round.

The scores gained in the 1/2 Final round do not count in the Final round. Each finalist starts with zero points. All riders start on same time. Free of choice of section.

- **Super Final round - two by two**

The Super Final round shall consist of 1 lap of 4 sections.

All riders will start in section number one; the riders must do the sections in order. The order to start will be determined by the result obtains in the Final round.

Riders that obtained fourth and third place in the Final round shall start together considering that rider with worst score in the Final round will start first on the sections.

Riders that obtained second and first place in the Final round will start once the previous riders have finished all four sections following same procedure.

Two riders will be presented on the start podium, after the rider's presentation both riders must go to section number one. The first rider shall start on the section. Once the first rider has finished the section number one, the second rider will start section number one. The same principle applies for the remaining sections.

Meanwhile the first rider can decide to wait or proceed to the next section.

Once a rider finished a section, the other rider has maximum one minute to start a section. After this minute the section time is running.

In case of mechanical problems, slight injury the other rider must overtake and start the section in front of him.

2. WORLD CUP REGISTRATION & PUBLICATIONS

Riders wishing and eligible to compete in a UCI Trials World Cup competition may register only under the auspices and through the agency of the national federation. All competition entry dates must be adhered to.

Entries for riders shall be submitted to the UCI by the federation of their nationality using the UCI online registration system (www.uci.ch).

The on-line registration system opens fifteen days before an event and closes on the Monday preceding the event at 12.00 am CET. A table showing these dates is published on the UCI web site. Late entries are refused unless authorised by the UCI, and on payment of a fine of CHF 100 for the first rider. Where more than one rider per national federation is involved, a total fine of CHF 200 must be paid.

A rider cannot compete in more than one class at UCI Trials World Cup event.
